You all performed phenomenally, and we are excited to see what the future holds for each of you. As celebrate our dancers' we incredible achievements at the German Championships of the Dance Street Factory Federation on September 21st, we also want to take a moment to reflect on the overall experience at the event, particularly in relation to the judging and organization.

First, we want to reiterate how incredibly proud we are of all our participants. Once again, congratulations to our champions your hard work, passion, and talent were nothing short of inspiring, and you set a high standard for all of us to admire.

Reflections on Our Experience with Dance Street Factory

However, while we celebrate these accomplishments, it is also important to share with you some challenges we faced at the competition. While the girls gave their absolute best and demonstrated true dedication, we encountered some unsatisfactory scoring and judgment that left us with significant concerns.

As your children's coach and dance trainer, it was heartbreaking to witness how some of our dancers were affected by the competition's outcome. Many of them were devastated and confused by their scores, particularly after the countless hours of hard work they had put in. Seeing these young girls heartbroken after giving their all was a reminder of how important it is for competitions to maintain a healthy, positive, and nurturing environment.

After the event, I reached out to the Dance Street Factory Federation to calmly and constructively express our concerns regarding the judging and how it affected the morale of our dancers. We were pleased with how the organization's management initially handled our feedback. They took our concerns seriously, discussed the matter with the judges, and showed a willingness to address the issues raised. It was a productive conversation that left us hopeful for improvements.

Unfortunately, things took a disappointing turn. Sergio, one of the judges from the event, took it upon himself to personally attack me (Karabo) on Instagram after the competition. This was not only unexpected but also deeply unprofessional, especially coming from someone who is responsible for judging young children. His behavior was not only disrespectful but also directly contradicted the values of fairness, support, and encouragement that we strive to uphold at Born 2 Dance. This situation left me incredibly concerned, as the safety and wellbeing of our children must always come first.

Prioritizing the Safety and Well-being of Our Students

At Born 2 Dance, our mission is to create a safe, fun, and nurturing environment for every child who walks through our doors. Dance is about more than just winning medals – it's about selfexpression, teamwork, building confidence, and fostering a love for movement. It was disheartening to see our dancers return from a competition feeling broken rather than uplifted. No child should leave an event feeling like their hard work wasn't valued.

After careful consideration, and in light of these events, we have made the difficult decision to no longer participate in any events organized by Dance Street Factory (As Born 2 Dance). We believe that by stepping away from this organization, we are prioritizing the best interests of our dancers and ensuring that we do not expose them to environments where they may be subjected to unfair treatment or bullying.

We want to make it very clear that this decision is based solely on our commitment to protecting our students and creating the best possible environment for them to grow and thrive as dancers and individuals. We do not tolerate bullying, and we will always stand up for our students to ensure they are treated with the respect and fairness they deserve.

Moving Forward: Supporting External Events

That being said, we still strongly encourage participation in external events and competitions, as they provide valuable experiences for personal growth. For those parents who wish to continue with the Dance Street Factory competitions, you are welcome to do so, but we kindly ask that you register your children privately, without any formal association to Born 2 Dance Studio. We will not be involved in the registration process with this particular organization.

Rest assured, we are here to fully support any child interested in competing, regardless of the competition they choose. We will continue to provide the training, preparation, choreography, and guidance necessary to help our dancers succeed. There are many reputable dance federations and competitions throughout Germany, and we encourage parents to explore these options.

Please don't hesitate to reach out to us if you need help navigating these opportunities or preparing your child for future competitions. For any other federations, parents are welcome to register through Born 2 Dance or use our dance studio for registration purposes but for Street Dance Factory registrations must not be made with our Dance Studio Name or affiliation.

Private Lessons

Please note that private lessons are available for all children from the first beginner level up to the highest level 5.

Some parents prefer their children to come to private lessons on a weekly basis. This decision is made by the parents themselves. This is not obligatory, you can take a private lesson once a month, twice or every week and you can choose not to take a private lesson at all.

It all depends on your wishes. I always recommend working privately with a child, as this allows them to improve their dance skills much faster. I can give more attention to their personal growth and development.

We have an online system for booking private lessons with a first come, first served service.

Fixed and regular appointments will of course be faded out. This will help me with the private lesson system. You will then book the appointments online and I will accept or decline them if there is not enough capacity. Many thanks in advance for your support!
